The jury of "Italia 2018" congratulates the Italian Federation for its decision to organize the second international exhibition of philatelic literature in Italy, after Italia82 in Milan, which was the very first in the FIP world. The jury thanks all the authors and publishers who presented their works at the exhibition which was the first that combined a large number of digital entries and, in particular, of very interesting websites.

The jurors did a preliminary assessment at home and then they met in Verona from 21st to 23rd November. The jury during the exhibition period reached unanimity of the evaluations working in a very friendly and constructive atmosphere. Exhibits were evaluated according to the new FEPA regulations covering both paper and digital entries.

Eliseo Ruben Otero (Argentina) served as jury consultant and Peter Suhadolc acted as jury secretary.

In view of the variety and quality of the exhibits, "Italia 2018" will become a milestone in the history of philatelic literature exhibitions.
