

# Foreign postal relations in the Kingdom of Italy

## Correspondence franked with the “Imperiale” series (21.4.1929 – 22.9.1943)

### Purpose of participation:

The collection includes correspondence from the Kingdom of Italy to foreign countries in the period between April 21, 1929 - the date of issue of the stamps - and September 22, 1943 - the last date before the advent of the Italian Social Republic. The Imperial series had a remarkable use in franking practically any type of correspondence; in those for abroad there are also uncommon if not extremely rare postal objects, reaching the five continents, countless countries and locations to the most unknown. Letters and postal objects with unusual destination or special postage rate are indicated with a yellow box. Notes in blue indicate known pieces.

### Historical postal situation:

The series commonly called "Imperial" unlike many philatelic issues, did not have an easy gestation.

Several artists, illustrious names, ventured into presenting the sketches and, after about two years.

In May 1924, the first six drawings were made official and presented to the press, ready to depict the new Italian stamps.

Times lengthened dramatically and after various vicissitudes the new ordinary series ran.

With a royal decree of 4 October 1928, the authorization was given, but the actual stamps appeared only on 21 April 1929.

On the basis of the regulations in force, the printing in default of postage, should not have taken place, but if the postcard and by extension to the printed matter, contained correspondence, they should have been delivered taxed. The fragment of paper that appears on the edge of the postcard is proof that the text was attached to it and therefore justified its forwarding. There are no taxes on the postcard as the legislation required that the document be delivered in a sealed envelope with the stamps affixed for the taxation.
